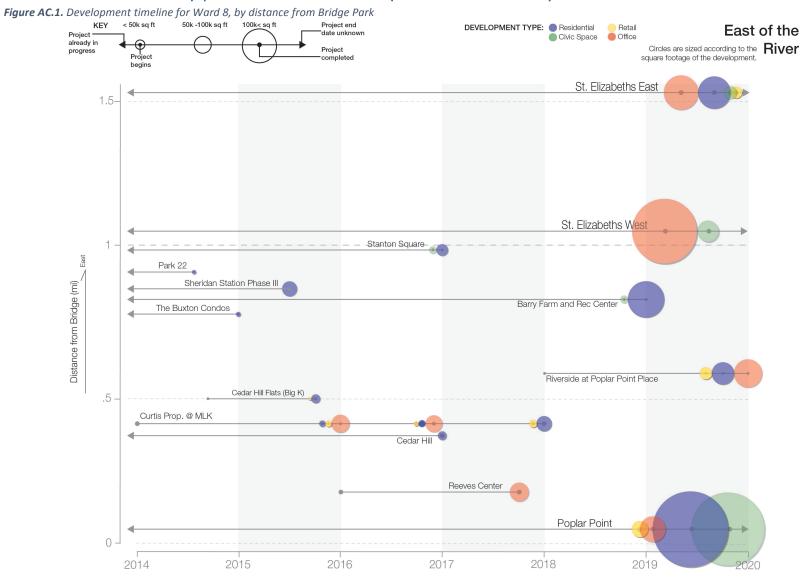


Figure AC.2. Development timeline for Ward 6, by distance from Bridge Park

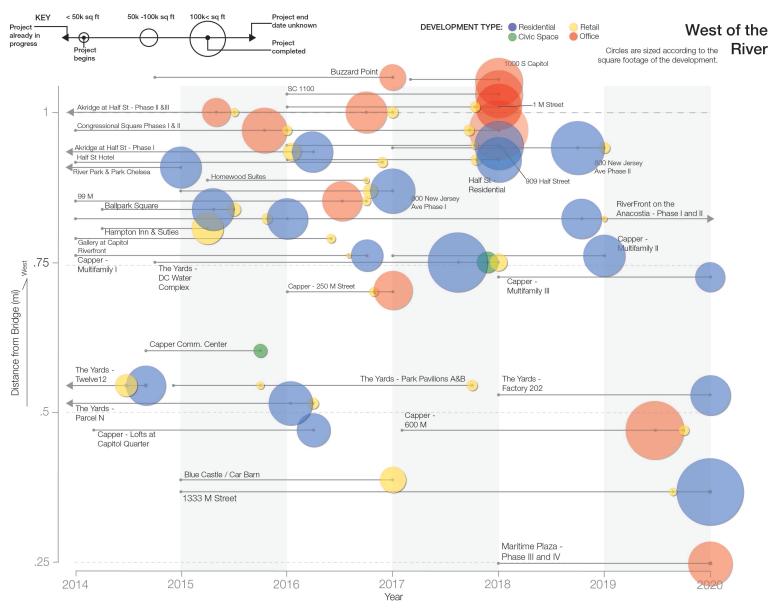
