### Rental Housing Resources

**For up to date information on renters' issues,** join the Housing Counseling Services (HCS) Tenant Rights and Responsibilities webinar, offered on the first and third Tuesdays of every month. ### Eviction Suspensions in DC

While rents have **NOT** been cancelled and remain due every month, evictions for tenants living in federally subsidized housing are suspended until August 25th following a 30-day notice for non-payment of rent.

The **District of Columbia** has suspended all evictions until the end of their respective states of emergency. Please remember that your rent is **still due** as normal and if unpaid at the conclusion of the period of suspension, you may still be evicted.

Tenants in **DC** must be offered a payment plan by their landlords to resolve delinquencies that result from the public health emergency and there is a ban on late fees and rent increases during the public health emergency. Learn more at our Tenant Rights Webinar.

Most **utility companies** have suspended the disconnection of services. Please contact your utility provider for more information.

### **Rental Assistance Programs**

HCS offers assistance for **individuals living with HIV or AIDS**: Emergency financial assistance programs to assist individuals living with HIV or AIDS in DC and Prince George's, Montgomery, Charles, Frederick and Calvert Counties in Maryland are available to help with rent, utilities, food and other necessities. To determine if you are eligible and to schedule a telephone application appointment. HCS offers assistance to **Veterans** through the Supportive Services for Veterans (SSVF) program: SSVF is designed to stabilize housing for homeless veterans and those at risk of homelessness in DC, Prince George's and Montgomery counties in Maryland and Fairfax and Arlington counties and the City of Alexandria in Virginia. HCS provides case management and financial assistance to assist homeless veterans to access emergency housing and rental apartments and provides rental assistance to veteran tenants who are at risk for homelessness. Additional services ensure that veterans remain safe at home. For more information call (202) 668-7366.

### **Washington, D.C. Rental Assistance Programs:**

The **COVID-19 Housing Assistance Program (CHAP)** offers up to three months of rental assistance for DC tenants who have been affected by the public health emergency. **Emergency Rental Assistance Program (ERAP)** offers rental assistance to low- income DC tenants who are at least 30 days delinquent in rent or who are homeless and need assistance to rent a new apartment.
